**STATISTICAL REVIEWS**  
**DAY 6 – OCTOBER 1, 2014**

- United States defeated Turkey 3-1 to record their sixth win in six matches at the 2014 World Championships. It is the fourth time that the USA start their campaign with six wins after 1982, 2002 and 2010.
- United States have won nine of their last 11 matches against teams from Europe, including all three matches in 2014, against Netherlands, Russia and Turkey.
- Serbia won 3-0 against Netherlands to claim their 13th straight-sets win at the World Championships and the first against a European side since a 3-0 win against Italy in 2006.
- Dominican Republic extended their winning streak to seven matches after beating Belgium 3-2.
- Dominican Republic became the first team in World Championship history to win four five-sets matches at a single edition.
- Croatia saw off Japan 3-2 to claim three wins in a row for the first time since 1998. In that year Japan was also the opponent in Croatia's third win.
- Russia also win their seventh World Championship match against Bulgaria (3-1). This was the second set they have lost against them in these seven matches.
- Russia have now their last 19 matches against European teams at the World Championships.
- Brazil win 3-0 against Kazakhstan to complete the winning set of 3-2 (Turkey), 3-1 (Serbia) and 3-0 (Kazakhstan) in consecutive matches.
- China beat Germany 3-0. It was china's six win in six matches at the 2014 worlds, and five of these wins came by 3-0 scores.
- Italy won 3-1 against Azerbaijan, despite handing 28 points (of 88 total) to Azerbaijan through errors.
- Italy are unbeaten in their last six World Championship matches against fellow European sides.
